FOLLOWING MSG IS FOR MR. HENRY KISSINGER AT THE
WHITE HOUSE FROM EGON BAHR:

"I WILL BE SPENDING THE PERIOD 5 TO 10 APRIL
IN WASHINGTON PRIVATELY. I WOULD VERY MUCH LIKE
TO SEE YOU IN ORDER TO PROVIDE YOU A BRIEFING
WHICH THE CHANCELLOR HAS ASKED ME TO GIVE YOU
ON THE DETAILS OF MY MOSCOW NEGOTIATIONS, SO THAT
THE CHANCELLOR WILL NOT HAVE TO GO OVER THESE
FINE DETAILS WHEN HE SEES THE PRESIDENT BUT CAN
SPEND MOST OF THE TIME DISCUSSING THE BROAD
IMPLICATIONS OF THE TALKS. IF AT ALL POSSIBLE,
WOULD PREFER SPEND WITH YOU EVENING OF 7 OR 8 APRIL, ✓
BUT NATURALLY AM AT YOUR DISPOSAL FOR WHATEVER DAY
IS BEST FOR YOU."

I look forward to seeing you in Washington privately. I hope you will be able to join me for a long luncheon on 8 April so that we can share the details of your Moscow negotiations. In addition, the President has asked me to ascertain whether or not it would be possible for me to have a private dinner with the Chancellor at Camp David on the night of 9 April. I would be grateful if you could confirm the suitability of our lunch date on the 8th as well as the private dinner with the Chancellor on the 9th. I look forward to seeing you again.
