US ARMY GARRISON-YONGSAN POLICY LETTER 3-2

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Implementation of Individual Antiterrorism Plan Tracking System/ Travel Tracker/Notifier

1. REFERENCES:

- a. USFK EFO 09-12 (Implementation of Individual Antiterrorism Plan Tracking System).
- b. USPACOM OPORD 5050-08
- c. USFK OPORD 5050-11

2. **PURPOSE:** To establish procedures for implementation of the Individual Antiterrorism Plan (IATP) Tracking System.

3. **APPLICABILITY:** This policy applies to all USAG Yongsan military personnel on official and un-official travel (i.e. TDY, TAD, PCS, and leave or any other type of official travel). DOD civilians and family members will use IATP/Travel Tracker/Notifier when on official travel. DOD civilians and family members are encouraged to use Travel Tracker if on un-official travel.

4. **POLICY:** The intent of this policy is to ensure the commander is informed regarding the travel plans of their personnel. The commander is alerted when personnel intend to proceed to a high-threat area or when personnel become located in a high threat area. IATP allows the commander to expeditiously inform Soldiers, civilians, and family members who are travelling outside the AO of events that may affect their safety.

5. PROCEDURES:

a. **Overview:** IATP/Travel Tracker/Notifier is a web based application accessed via the NIPRNET. It is CAC-enabled and users will be prompted for CAC card verification. No password is required to access the site, at the following link: <https://iatp.pacom.mil>.

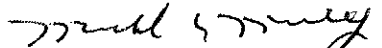
b. Requirements:

1. Only certain countries in the USAPACOM AO require an "Approved IATP" (approval varies by rank and is dependent upon threat-level). The application identifies which countries or locations actually require and "approved IATP" versus an optional short form that provides the same accountability and notification features less the approval process.

2. An IATP submission via IATP /Travel Tracker/Notifier does not constitute a request for authorization to travel. Such requests shall be submitted and approved by the traveler's chain of command prior to using IATP/Travel Tracker/Notifier.

3. All personnel are encouraged to complete the individual training about the IATP/travel tracker/Notified that is also located at the following link:
