AGE MATRIX

Parents and guardians are responsible for the welfare and safety of children in the military community. Each child is unique. Personality, environment, developmental progress and maturity level are factors used to determine when children are ready to accomplish activities with little or no supervision. *Parents are responsible for making this decision.* The following are minimum community standards; under no circumstances will grades for activities be reduced. Parents are still **required** to assess their children and, if necessary, raise the grade, and to follow any differing preset restrictions such as school bus requirements. These guidelines apply to military and DOD personnel living on or off post.
