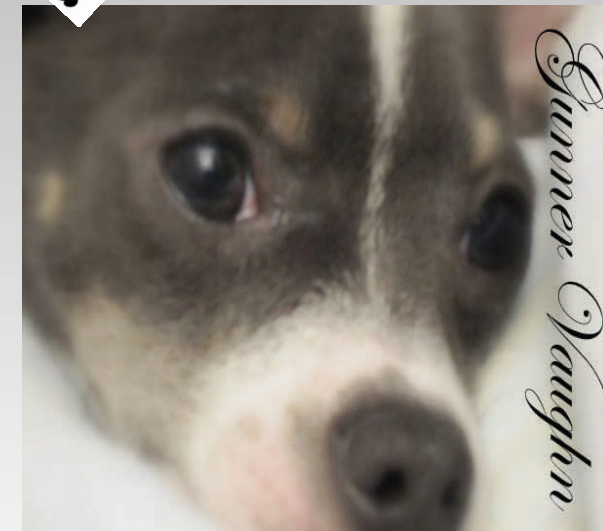
Check List

- Register your pet within 14 days.
- Make sure your pet has a Micro Chip that is readable in Europe.
- Make sure your pet breed is on the authorized list of pets allowed in Germany.
- Only two dogs or cats per household.
- Make sure to inform the housing office of the number & type of pets you have.
- Make sure to dispose of your pet's waste.
- Never leave your pet outside unattended.
- Never leave your pet outside overnight.
- Pets must always be on a leash when outdoors.
- ALWAYS report pet bites to the MP Station ASAP.

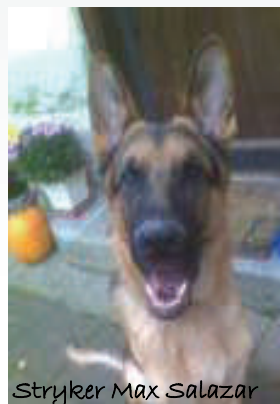
Class 1 dogs may not be owned or brought into Bavaria.

- Pit-Bull
- Bandog
- American Staffordshire Terrier
- Tosa Inu
- Any dog mixed with any Class 1 dog



Class 2 dogs may be owned and brought into Bavaria, provided the dog passes a temperament test and are certified as peaceful by an authorized German veterinarian.

- Alano
- American Bulldog
- Bullmastiff, Mastiff
- Bullterrier
- Cane Corso
- Dog Argentino
- Dogue de Bordeaux
- Fila Brasileiro
- Mastino Espaniol
- Perro de Presa Canario (Dogo Canario)
- Perro de Pressa Malloquin
- Rottweiler
- Any dog mixed with any Class 2 dog



**Family Housing
Pet Ownership Responsibilities in
Government Quarters.**



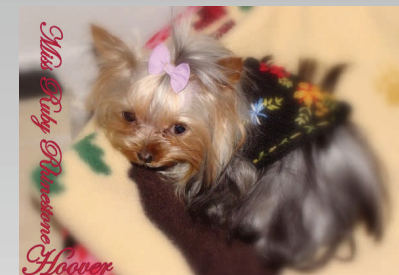
1. Pets must be controlled in such a manner that they do not become a public nuisance. Excessive barking and defecating or urinating by dogs on balconies, playgrounds or lawns within the immediate vicinity of the Family quarters is considered a nuisance.
2. All pets, when outside quarters, must be leashed and accompanied by an individual capable of controlling them.
3. Occupants owning or keeping animals are responsible for all damages caused by the animals.
4. The breeding and raising of pets on government property for the express purpose of profit is prohibited.
5. Pets must be kept indoors at night.
6. Pet must not be left unattended for extended periods in quarters, storage rooms, attics, basements or on balconies.
7. Pets must not be tied to any outside structure, permanent or otherwise and left unattended.
8. Owners are responsible for the disposal of deceased pets.

*****All pets must be registered with the Veterinary Treatment Facility within 14 days of purchase or arrival in country. There is no charge for registration and may be done without an appointment; however, registration must be done in person.**



******Ownership of more than two regular domestic animals (such as a dog and a cat) in a Family housing unit is prohibited.** A copy of the registration for dogs will be provided to the Housing Office. A reasonable number of small domestic animals, such as birds, fish, and rodents, which are kept indoors within the quarters in a cage or tank, are permissible. Keeping exotic pets or any type of poisonous creatures (snakes, etc.) in government quarters is not authorized.
