Transportation

The subject gentlemen are all flying out to California aboard commercial transportation. Details are as follows:

Hobart Lewis and Robert Abplanalp -TWA Flight #87 (originating in New York) -Arrive Los Angeles International Airport 11:30 A.M. (PDT) -Friday, April 30

Bebe Rebozo -National Airlines Flight #41 (originating in Florida) -Arrive Los Angeles International Airport 11:10 a.m. (PDT) -Friday, April 30
