U.S. Jewery has an interest in our firmness in Southeast Asia. While Goodell, Javits et al complain about U.S. assistance to Southeast Asia, they have been urging stepped up aid to Israel. It seems to me that if the Jewish leadership could come out four-square behind the President on Cambodia, it would put a real squeeze on Goodell and friends.
