SUBJECT: Jimmy Hoffa

You'll recall I introduced you to Wallace Clements, a Teamster organizer, several weeks ago. Wallace is from my hometown and has been active in Teamsters' political arm DRIVE for many years. He is close to Hoffa and is of some interest in Jimmy's parole.

Mr. Clements has requested an appointment with you sometime in September to discuss this matter in privacy. He will bring a high union leader with him.

While I recognize this normally would be a Justice matter, I feel consideration of a parole has to be well thought out at the highest level.
