Subject: Desegregation Problems

Ed Morgan is meeting daily with HEW and Justice to try to ease the burden of this Fall's total desegregation order of the court. Ed will personally follow-up on specific complaints of unreasonable attitudes of government officials, unique problems, etc.

As a service to our friends, could you call Senators and Representatives on attached lists to request they send me in writing the facts of any school situation where they feel HEW or Justice personnel are acting not in accord with the President's wishes. This is not to say we are planning to violate the Court order or law.


Those Members with asterisks will get priority attention but all complaints will be investigated. Contact should point out we're trying to be helpful and publicity of this service would be self-defeating.
