Findley Resolution of inquiry regarding V.P. Agnew.

House Judiciary Committee is to meet on Thursday, the 6th legislative day of the 7 allowed, to act on this privileged resolution. Minority Counsel Frank Polk, expects it to be reported with a recommendation that it be tabled.

Attorney General Richardson in a letter to Rodino this week, opposes the Resolution "in its present form." He reminds the Committee of his offer to wait until after possible indictment for the House to consider impeachment proceedings, should that circumstance arise. He would be willing to work out with the Committee an exchange of information.

Richardson feels it would be improper for the House to act while the Grand Jury remains in session.
