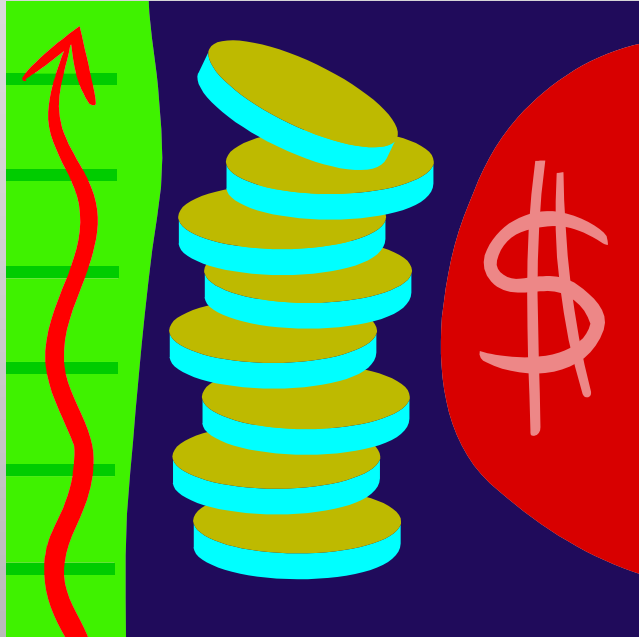

- **Output:** 50 students will participate in a computer-based training program.
- **Outcome:** At least 42 students will pass the Xyz Certification Test.

Training/economic development

Ten companies will receive training and five companies will participate in an international show.

Participating companies will show at least \$5 million in new export sales and create five new export related jobs.

175 people from 117 businesses, four counties, and one municipality will participate in the project. 8 new businesses and 12 new jobs will be created.

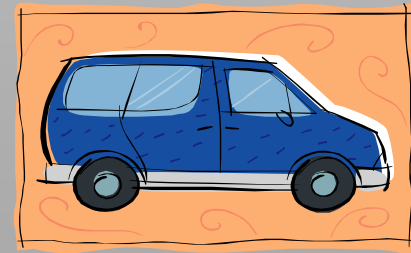

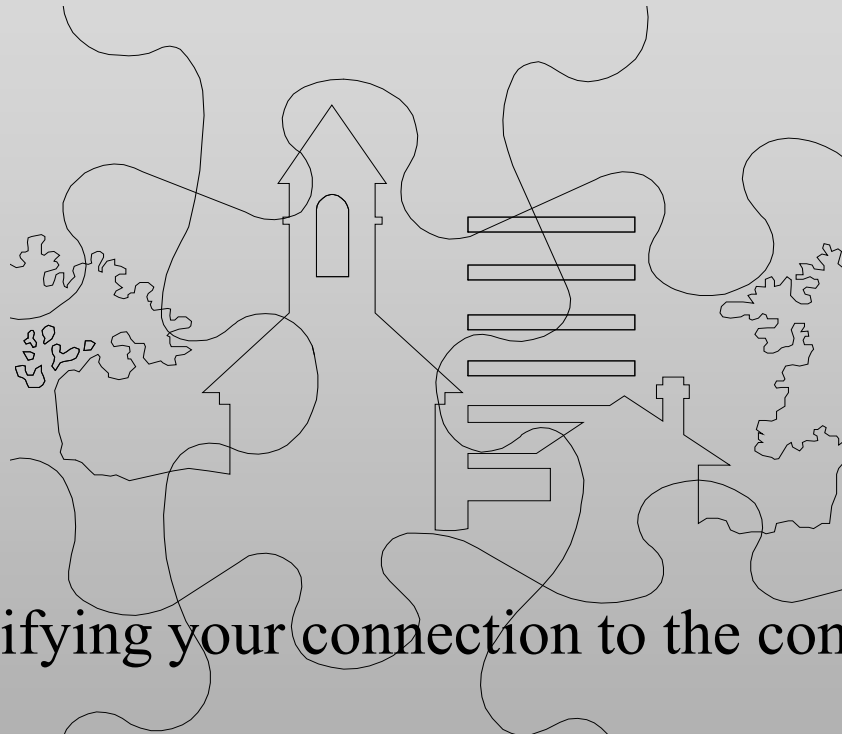

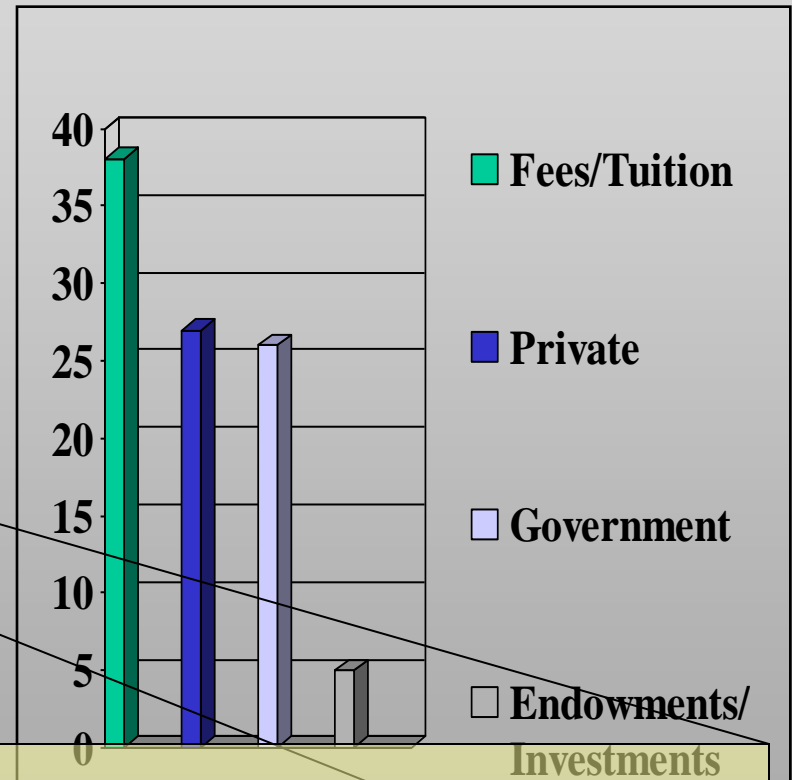

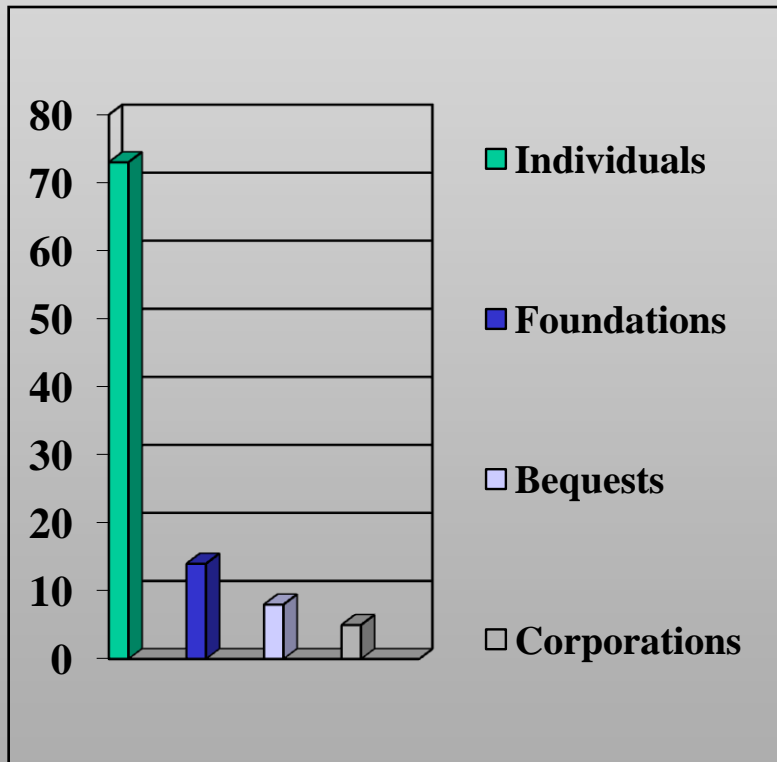

Essential Resources: Money

Points to remember!

- Short-term funding is not the same as “immediate funding”.
- Short-term funding is not for covering “short falls”.
- If you need the money *now*, it is too late.

Journey as metaphor

- Grants facilitate the journey, they are not the goal
- Grant funding is short-term
- Three main purposes
 - ◆ Start-up costs
 - ◆ Supplemental, expansion and special initiatives
 - ◆ Emergency situations
- Grants are not for on-going operations.
