# What is a Wireless Device?

#### **Examples are:**

- Cell Phones
- Baby Monitors
- Cordless Phones
- Low Power Handheld Radios (FRS/GMRS)
- Radio Controlled Model Airplanes
- Automobile Keyless Entry Systems
- Various Computer Components (keyboard, mouse, printers, wireless LAN systems, etc.)



## Wireless Devices in the U.S.

 Federal Communications Commission (FCC) approval

- Commonly called "PART 15" devices
  - Cannot cause harmful interference
  - Must accept interference from authorized users
  - Can be operated without a license in the U.S. provided they have not been modified in anyway, e.g., power amplifiers added


