He serves as the principal advisor to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Affairs) on all matters pertaining to the total force structure and associated military, civilian and contractor manpower in the Active and Reserve Components (1.1M Soldiers, 280K Civilians, and 240K Contractors), all Program Objective Memorandum (POM) resources for programs under ASA (M&RA) oversight (\$464B), and all manpower and personnel issues associated with force structure requirements of new weapon systems. Mr. Aronowitz also provides direct oversight of the USA Manpower Analysis Agency.
