In 1988, he moved back to the US and resided in the Washington, DC area working as a Project Manager for Sigal Construction Corp on numerous projects such as; Penn Plaza on 601 Penn Ave, American College of Cardiology in Bethesda, MD and the Gannett / USA Today towers in Arlington, VA.

Since joining Contrack in 1994, Mr. Hakki has been responsible for overseeing operations at the company's U.S. Headquarters office.

Activities include overseeing all bidding, U.S. material procurement, engineering review and quality control, shipping/logistics and administrative functions in addition to monitoring the staff of engineers and administrative personnel. Mr. Hakki frequently travels to the project sites overseas and meets with the staff and with the clients.
