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7 Consultation and Coordination

Federal, state, and local agencies and Native American Indian tribes were consulted prior to and during the preparation of this SEIS. Agencies were notified of plans for closure and disposal activities by mail; by scheduled public meetings associated with the reuse planning process; by publication of a Notice of Intent (NOI) announcing preparation of a Draft SEIS; by a public scoping meeting and community outreach meetings, and by a public hearing on the Draft SEIS. The agencies' viewpoints were solicited with regard to activities and issues within their jurisdiction. The agencies and tribes contacted include those listed in this Chapter, which are part of the larger distribution list for notification of availability of the Draft SEIS (Chapter 10, SEIS Distribution List).
