ENVIRONMENTAL AND NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

Summary. This change revises policy regarding the washing of privately owned vehicles (POVs) in Fort Gordon housing areas.

Suggested improvements. The proponent of this regulation is the Directorate of Public Works (DPW). Users may send comments and suggested improvements on Department of the Army (DA) Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms) through channels to Commander, USASC&FG, ATTN: ATZH-DIE, Fort Gordon, Georgia 30905-5040 and/or submit DA Form 1045 (Army Ideas for Excellence Program (AIEP) Proposal) to installation AIEP coordinator.

USASC&FG Regulation 200-2, 1 December 1997, is changed as follows:

Page 26. Paragraph 3-2f(3)(f) is superseded as follows:

(f) Unauthorized Vehicle Washing. No vehicles or equipment will be washed in any creek, pond, or other natural body of water or drainage system. Privately owned vehicles (POVs) may be washed at established washing facilities. The exterior of POVs may be washed in quarters areas, but POV engines and undercarriages may be washed only at wash facilities.
