HD EARTH VIEWS FROM SPACE

A collection of 23 video clips of Earth captured by cameras aboard the Space Shuttle and the International Space Station. The space station orbits Earth every 90 minutes from an altitude of about 220 miles, at an approximate speed of 17,500 miles per hour.

The clips are approximately 10-20 seconds long and are available for download in QuickTime 1280x720.
