

Wearing of the WAMC ID Badge

MEDCEN Regulation 25-1, dated 17 JUN 10

- WAMC's distinctive identification (ID) badge is used for the purpose of readily identifying oneself to patients, staff and visitors.
- The badge is one's personal ID and cannot be/will not be loaned out for any purpose.
- The ID badge will be worn upon entering the medical center, its buildings and grounds, and at all times when providing patient care.
- Once outside of the WAMC facility, outlying clinics, and campus, the ID badge will be removed from public view.
- The ID badge must also be worn during the conduct of official business within WAMC during after-duty hours, holidays, and weekends.

To ensure the safety of staff and patients, and to prevent unauthorized personnel from entering "non-patient" areas such as Log/Facilities area ground floor, back hallways, service elevators, etc., as a Random Anti-Terrorism measure (RAM), Security personnel will identify and document personnel who fail to conform to this regulation.
