WHAT IS IT?

An Energy Use Reduction Program sponsored by the Central Florida Energy Efficiency Alliance (CFEEA) created to reduce commercial building energy use 30% by June 30, 2012. Businesses are encouraged to register their building(s) online and gain access to free tracking tools, personal consulting, marketing benefits, and an opportunity to compete for the CFEEA Energy Efficiency Community Awards in 2010.

5 SIMPLE STEPS TO TAKE THE KILOWATT CRACKDOWN CHALLENGE

CENTRAL FLORIDA BUSINESSES AND CFEEA MEMBERS

- 1. Register your building(s) online at www.kwcrackdown.com
- Follow the step-by-step guide to input the energy use information of your building(s) into the Energy Star Portfolio Manager Program.
 - Load 12 months of energy use info from utility bills for each building.
 - Share access with CFEEA in order to be included for Community Awards.
- 3. Assess the performance of your building(s) using valid EPA Benchmark scores. Identify target areas for improvement.
 - Look for "low hanging fruits" (minimal to no cost changes) to create/update your energy efficiency improvement plan and implement changes.
 - Engage employees in energy efficiency measures to contribute awareness and increase your efforts.
- 4. Agree to work towards 10% energy efficiency improvement annually for each building.
- 5. Use the Energy Star Portfolio Manager to track monthly energy use data and create new goals and initiatives.
