The Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive has just completed a revision bringing important changes to be applied across Europe in 18 months time.

The Energy Using Products (EuP) Directive has entered into a very important stage as implementing measures affecting specific products have been agreed and are now coming into force.

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive is undergoing a revision that will bring about key changes.
