WIESBADEN SCHOOL BUS OFFICE INFORMATION SHEET

This package contains information regarding school bus safety and transportation procedures that each student must follow while being transported. Please remember, that it is strongly advised that your child be at the assigned bus stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled departure time. It is also a requirement that each student utilizing bus transportation have their bus pass with them when riding to or from school.

Please remember that bus transportation is a privilege, not a right, and along with this privilege comes parental responsibility for the behavior of your child. You, the parent are responsible for the behavior of your child at all times while utilizing bus transportation. Students granted transportation privileges are responsible for complying with the "School Bus Rules" and conducting themselves in a safe and proper manner. Please see the "Behavior Standards for School Bus Students" contained within this information packet. Inappropriate behavior by your child may result in the loss of school bus service, which would then require you, the parent, to transport your child to school.

Information pertaining to normal arrival/departure times on bus routes can be obtained by calling the numbers listed below. In the event of inclement weather, please tune to AFN 98.7 FM (*The Eagle*) for school delays or closure information or check the USAG Wiesbaden website at the Road, Weather and School Closure Information Link. USAG Wiesbaden determines the cancellation of school bus services for the Wiesbaden school community. This includes Wiesbaden High School, Wiesbaden Middle School, Hainerberg Elementary School and Aukamm Elementary School.

Concerns regarding transportation or student behavior should be reported to the administration of your student's school or this office as soon as possible. Help us to help keep our children safe by reporting all concerns. Serious complaints should be in writing. You may email or fax your complaint to our office. Please be assured that your concerns are our concerns and that we take the **SAFE** transportation of your children as an extremely serious and important job! We realize that we are "*Transporting Our Future*".



SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION WHAT NEWCOMERS TO EUROPE NEED TO KNOW

Department of Defense Dependents Schools (DoDDS) operates transportation services for children attending Department of Defense (DoD) schools in Europe. Services include daily busing to and from school, as well as transportation for students participating in school-sponsored field trips, academic and athletic competitions, and other special events.

KEY FACTS ABOUT DAILY TRANSPORTATION

The location of family quarters, not the sponsor's place of duty or work, determines which school children attend and their eligibility for transportation.

Distance to the assigned school determines whether children ride the bus or walk. The standard for transportation of elementary school children is more than one mile and for secondary school children more than 1.5 miles. Approximately one half of the 50,000 children attending DoD schools in Europe ride the bus, with the other half walking or using other transportation.

Family quarters must also be within the commuting area. Housing referral offices have information about the commuting area and its boundaries.

Children enrolled in pre-Kindergarten and Sure-Start programs and those with an Individual Education Program (IEP) may receive specialized transportation services tailored to the child's age and/or IEP requirements.

Transportation to DoD schools in Europe is a lot like that in the United States, but with key operational and safety differences.

DoDDS does not own buses or employ drivers, but contracts with hostnation commercial companies for transportation services.

Buses are not the yellow vehicles familiar to American children, but European-style tourist (see image 1) or city transit coaches (see image 2) marked with the international school bus sign (see image 3), front and back.

Drivers are not required to speak English, only the host-nation language. Buses are equipped with two-way communications, either radio or cellular telephone, linking drivers to the contractor's central control desk.

Drivers are not required to enforce good order and discipline on the bus. Their job is to operate the bus safely. Parents are responsible for their children's behavior on the bus.

Because even one child's misbehavior can interfere with safe operation of the bus and endanger everyone on board, disciplinary action is taken on infractions, including temporary suspension or permanent revocation. Transportation is a privilege, not a right or entitlement. Safety is paramount.

In Europe, TRAFFIC IS NOT REQUIRED TO STOP for loading and unloading school buses. American children must follow this life-saving rule: NEVER CROSS THE STREET IN FRONT OF OR BEHIND THE BUS.








Registration of children with the school is the first step. Next is a visit to the school transportation office (parents and children) to register for transportation, receive a mandatory bus pass and information on routes, stops and schedules, safety, and behavior standards and discipline rules.

PROTECT YOUR CHILDREN

Take 5 minutes to teach them these 5 school bus safety rules

- Rule number one: Walk don't run, You can have fun, But walk don't run.
- Rule number two: Just take three, Steps from the curb, Easily!
- Rule number three: Take your seat, And please stay seated, Till the journey is complete.
- Rule number four: Is like 2 & 2, Three steps back from the curb, We must do.
- Rule number five: I should not play, In front of the bus, No way!

REMEMBER!

In Europe, traffic does not stop for loading or unloading school buses. Crossing the street can be dangerous.

SPECIAL NOTICE FOR PARENTS OF K-2 STUDENTS

Children in kindergarten through grade 2 are our littlest passengers and most vulnerable to accidents going to/from and waiting at bus stops. They need your supervision to keep them safe.

Please personally take your children to the bus stop.

Wait with them.

Meet them when they return.

MEMORANDUM FOR PARENTS OF BUS RIDERS

SUBJECT: Lost Child Procedures/Information.

In the event that your child does not arrive home on the designated bus within 30 minutes of his/her normal arrival time: The student may be with another family member or a neighborhood friend. If you are concerned that your child is late, we suggest that you first contact your spouse or any of your older children, if possible, to check if the child is with them. Your assistance in supplying the above information is deeply appreciated.

DoDEA BEHAVIOR STANDARDS FOR SCHOOL BUS STUDENTS

ON AND AROUND SCHOOL BUSES STUDENTS WILL:

- 1. Comply with all school rules with the "Behavior Standards for School Bus Students."
- 2. Board and exit the bus in an orderly, safe manner.
- 3. Present bus pass when boarding the bus, and upon demand.
- 4. Remain seated while on the bus.
- 5. Talk with other passengers in a normal voice.
- 6. Keep all parts of the body inside the bus windows.
- 7. Keep aisles, steps, and empty seats free from obstruction.
- 8. Remain fully and properly clothed.
- 9. Treat the driver and fellow students with respect.
- 10. Promptly comply with the bus driver's or monitor's instructions.
- 11. Treat the bus and other private property with care.

ON OR AROUND SCHOOL BUSES STUDENTS WILL NOT:

- 1. Fight, push, shove, or trip other passengers
- 2. Use or possess unacceptable items identified in the school "Code of Conduct."
- 3. Push while boarding, on, or exiting the bus.
- 4. Get on or off the bus while the bus is in motion.
- 5. Make excessive noise, or play electronic equipment without earplugs.
- 6. Put objects out of bus windows or hang out of windows.
- 7. Engage in horseplay.
- 8. Obstruct aisles, steps, or seats.
- 9. Engage in public displays of affection.
- 10. Eat, drink, or litter on the bus.
- 11. Use profane or abusive language or make obscene gestures.
- 12. Spit or bite.
- 13. Harass, bully, or interfere with other students.
- 14. Disrespect, distract or interfere with bus driver.
- 15. Damage private property.
- 16. Sit in the bus driver's seat, or touch bus operating devises or equipment.
- 17. Open or try to open bus door.
- 18. Throw or shoot objects inside or out of bus.
- 19. Tamper with bus controls or emergency equipment.
- 20. Violate any other school rule, law or military installation regulation.

- 1. All rule infractions are cumulative. A series of minor infractions may result in serious consequences.
- 2. All misconduct must be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Depending upon severity, warnings, removals, or expulsions may be deemed appropriate regardless of sequence or frequency of misconduct instance.
- 3. Older students are expected to behave more maturely and thoughtfully than younger students, therefore, will be held more responsible for the consequences of their conduct.
- 4. Possession of weapons or prohibited items, as described by this Regulation or other military regulations, controlled substances, alcohol, or other serious incidents will be reported on Form 4705 and may result in removal or expulsion from school in addition to the loss of bus privileges.
