MEMORANDUM FOR AFOSI OTS APPLICANTS

SUBJECT: OTS Accession Applications for AFOSI Career Field

- 1. Officer Training School (OTS) applicants desiring to compete for accession into the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI) career field will do so at the same time as an OTS selection board. To illustrate this process, after an OTS board concludes, HQ AFPC/DPALB1 will review the records for applicants selected for OTS and extract prior enlisted OSI agent selectees and those members that have 71S (AFOSI Officer Air Force Specialty Code) listed as primary career field designation (NOTE: If there are enough AFOSI OTS selectees to meet AFOSI OTS accession quotas, AFOSI/CC will not direct an AFOSI accession board to convene). Once selectee files are pulled, a separate selection board will convene to evaluate potential accession into AFOSI. The results of the selection board will be provided to AFRS/RSOCL for classification to the 71S AFSC.
- 2. AFOSI OTS selectees will be announced with the OTS AFSC announcement. Those selected will attend a future OTS course determined by the Air Force Recruiting Service. Once selected, an Applicant Suitability Investigation for non-prior enlisted AFOSI agents will be conducted by the AFOSI field unit located on the respective installation or the nearest field unit in the case of civilian OTS selectees. If suitability is approved and after completion of OTS, the member will be scheduled to attend initial skills training at the U.S. Air Force Office of Special Investigations Academy, Glynco, GA, which is co-located with the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center. If not approved for suitability, the member will not be processed for AFOSI duty and will be reviewed for other career field classification. HQ AFPC/DPALB1 will coordinate approved agent selectee's future assignment with HQ AFOSI/DP throughout the process.
