

Ramstein Spouse's Orientation (RSO)

The RSO is a program designed to educate spouses who are new to the German culture and/or anyone desiring to increase their knowledge of the Kaiserslautern Military Community (KMC). The briefing is held every Monday from 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. (lunch is provided) in the Airman & Family Readiness Center (A&FRC), Bldg. 2120.

The program consists of briefings from various installations agencies (e.g., Education Center, Non-Appropriated Funds Human Resource Management, Office of Special Investigation, etc.) and the German Cultural Liaison Officer will provide a lively briefing on German "societal norms." Spouses new to the area are highly encouraged to sign up as soon as they arrive by calling the A&FRC at 480-5100 (DSN) or 06371475100 (commercial).

What is What?

"What is What?" is a guided shopping tour to an off- base German grocery store to familiarize participants with shopping on the German economy. Payment options, warranties and VAT refunds are explained – as are German products. This class is also designed to provide tips for saving money by frequenting stores in the German Community.

Intro to German

The Intro to German language class is a one-hour class provided weekly for four weeks during the lunch hour. Participants are encouraged to bring their lunch to class. The class teaches a very compressed overview of the German language – with the focus being on how to communicate

requirements for basic necessities and/or survival skills. It also gives a chance to experience the German language before deciding to join a longer and more detailed language program.
