



Employment Assistance

Like many other overseas locations, Ramstein is a challenging environment for spouses who are seeking employment. It is not uncommon for applicants to wait 6 months or longer to gain a job commensurate with their education and/or experience. The length of time spent unemployed varies with the applicant's skills, determination, and timing. The job market is continually changing as people relocate into and out of the area.

The Airman & Family Readiness Center (A&FRC) assists spouses with employment by providing resources related to the job search. The Employment Assistance program is designed to assist spouses with developing their job search strategy. Many spouses choose to use an overseas assignment as a time to work on developing new skills through paid employment, volunteerism, and/or education.
