The EFMP is designed to provide support to military family members with special needs. The Medical function provides identification, enrollment and clearance to ensure appropriate medical and educational services are available for family members before they PCS to a new location. The Family Support function provides information, referrals, parent education and recreational events. The worldwide network of EFMP-Family Support offers transition assistance from installation to installation.

The Ramstein EFMP-Family Support has partnered with community organizations to develop adaptive activities for families with special needs.
