FORT BENNING, GA – The Army is preparing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to analyze the potential impacts of the Training Land Expansion Program at Fort Benning. The proposed actions include land expansion to support training needs. The Army will hold public scoping meetings at the locations below, and invites your participation to identify issues/concerns associated with the proposed action, to define the scope of analysis for the EIS, and to identify reasonable alternatives and mitigations. The meetings will be held in an open house format (meaning there are no formal presentations), and your participation will assist in the process.
