Brown - makes more sense to get a handle on health care costs first.
- without mandates, 91% would be covered within 1st year in the Brown/Cooper bill
- Go market based 1st; if don't work, lets look at mandates
- Doesn't like individual mandate
- Came out under 10, but no mandate for individual + employer mandate

Daschle - We have a mandate to pay for the uninsured by those who are now insured. It's the most inequitable mandate of all.
- 2/3 of Americans still support a mandate for even small businesses

Wellstone - We cannot retreat from commitment to comprehensive health for all Americans. Universal coverage is part of cost containment. Cost shifting, etc

Roddeheller - If we delay universal coverage & not put in a bill, Congress would act for at least 5 more years.

Kerrey - Clinton / Chafee / Brown - We can get a piece of legislation. Lots of common denominators why are we still arguing - Let's start dealing. ~~Q~~ Questions can we write a bill?

Wofford - Kennedy bill has made significant steps forward. Is Brown saying 10% under -
