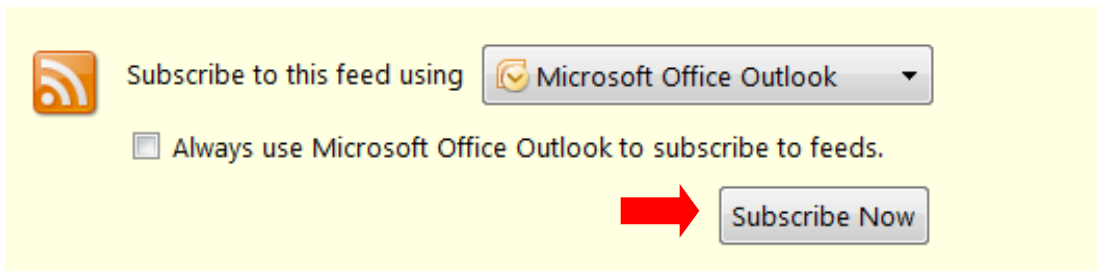

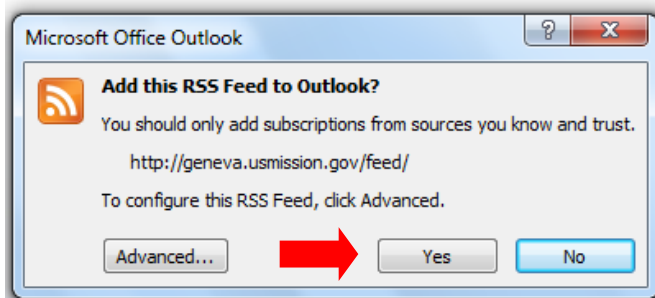

5. Then click Subscribe.

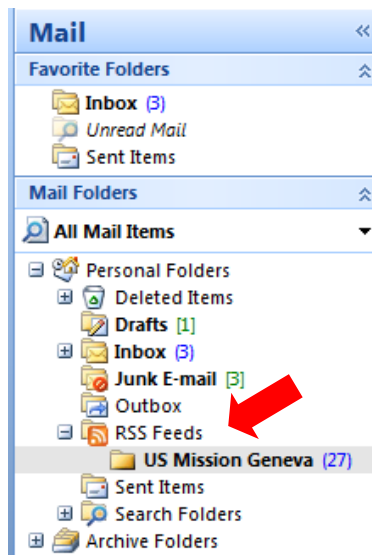


Click Yes.
