Course Overview: The Combat Lifesaver Re-Certification Course is designed to validate and refresh the skills learned by non-medical soldiers in emergency medical care as their secondary mission. The course reviews the principles and practices of Tactical Combat Casualty Care and provides soldiers with updates on new materials, techniques, and/or equipment available since their last certification. CLS skills such as bleeding control, airway and breathing management, transport and packaging of casualties to prevent hypothermia are reviewed and evaluated.

Target Audience: For all active and reserve non-medical
military personnel and DoD civilians currently certified as

combat lifesavers whose certification period has reached or is about to reach 12 months.
