Located in the hospital "C" Building 3rd floor, the Behavioral Health Department provides comprehensive mental health treatment to adult beneficiaries which includes medication and therapeutic intervention

Army Substance Abuse Program

Child & Adolescent Psychiatry Service

Family Advocacy Program provides assessment and treatment for victims, offenders and Families experiencing child and/or adult abuse/neglect.

Marriage and Family Therapists provide individual, couple, family and group therapy. Counselors practice short-term, solution-focused therapy with focus on improving communication and problem solving.

Hospital Social Work provides services to patients and BACH staff. They provide psychosocial needs assessments, advocacy, stress/crisis management and support groups. They also provide sexual assault treatment and case management.

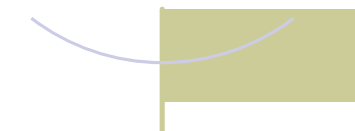
