Performs duties of CSO to accomplish mobility, training, and other assigned missions. Related DoD Occupational Group 220400

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTIONS FACTORS

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applicants are subject to review by the FSS Commander. If all mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations. Applicants may meet an Officer Screening and Interview Board (OSIB)
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in ANGI 36-2005.
- **NOTE:** Undergraduate Flying Training applicants must be less than 30 years of age prior to entering into formal training.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking, intelligence, and weather information. Participates in mission planning, preparation and filing of flight plan, and crew briefing. Ensures aircraft is preflighted, inspected, loaded equipped and manned for mission.
- Navigates aircraft to accomplish assigned mission. Operates available navigation systems.
- Conducts or supervises training of crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training.
- Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty

KNOWLEDGE:

- Knowledge is mandatory of theory of flight, air navigation, meteorology, flying directives, aircraft operating procedures, and mission tactics.

EDUCATION:

- For entry into this specialty, an undergraduate degree specializing in physical sciences, mathematics, administration, or management is desirable.

TRAINING: The following training is mandatory as indicated:

- For entry into this specialty, completion of Air Force Specialized Undergraduate Navigator Training (SUNT) or Undergraduate CSO training.
- For award of AFSC 12M3X, completion of transition and operational training in the C-130E/H specific aircraft.

EXPERIENCE:

- For upgrade to AFSCs 12M3X, unit commander determines proficiency based on performance, experience, and completion of minimum training requirements.

OTHER: The following are mandatory as indicated: For award and retention of these AFSCs, current aeronautical rating and qualification for aviation service as CSO are mandatory.

INTERVIEW: An Officer Screening Interview Board may be convened to interview all qualified applicants. Applicants will be informed in writing, or telephonically of date and time to appear.

Commissioned Officers: Applicants will prepare and forward a Cover letter, Resume, an AF Form 24, Application of Appointment as Reserve of the Air Force or USAF Without Component, vMPF, Records Review RIP, current Physical Fitness Evaluation Report and DD Form 2807-2, MEDICAL PRESCREEN OF MEDICAL HISTORY REPORT.
