Pilots mobility aircraft; Commands crews to accomplish tanker, airlift, training, and other missions. Related DoD Occupational Group: 220200.

## QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTIONS FACTORS

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applicants are subject to review by the FSS Commander. If all mandatory requirements are met as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interview Board (OSIB)
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in ANGI 36-2005.

## Duties and Responsibilities:

- Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking, intelligence, and weather information. Supervises mission planning, preparation, filing a flight plan, and crew briefing. Ensures aircraft is pre-flight inspected, loaded, equipped, and manned for mission.
- Pilots aircraft and commands crew. Operates aircraft controls and equipment. Performs, supervises, or directs navigation, in-flight refueling, and cargo and passenger delivery.
- Conducts or supervises training of crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training.
- Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.

**KNOWLEDGE:** Knowledge is mandatory of theory of flight, air navigation, meteorology, flying directives, aircraft operating procedures, and mission tactics.

**EDUCATION:** For entry into this specialty, undergraduate degree specializing in physical sciences, mathematics, administration, or management is desirable.

**TRAINING:** The following training is mandatory as indicated:

- For entry into this specialty, completion of Air Force Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training (SUPT).
- For award of AFSC 11M2B, completion of transition and operational training in the C-130E/H specific aircraft.

**EXPERIENCE:** For upgrade to AFSCs 11M2B, unit commander determines proficiency based on performance, experience, and completion of minimum training requirements.

**OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:** The following are mandatory as indicated:

For award and retention of this AFSC current aeronautical rating and qualification for aviation service as pilot.

**INTERVIEW:** An Officer Screening Interview Board may be convened to interview all qualified applicants. Applicants will be informed in writing, or telephonically of date and time to appear.
