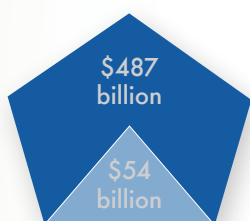
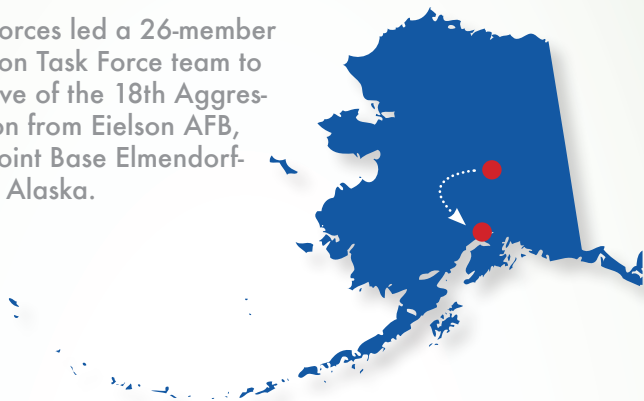


AIR FORCE SAVINGS
