Today: Rain showers beginning early morning will remain throughout the day. Winds will be from the northeast at 14 mph. Low 39F, High 46F.

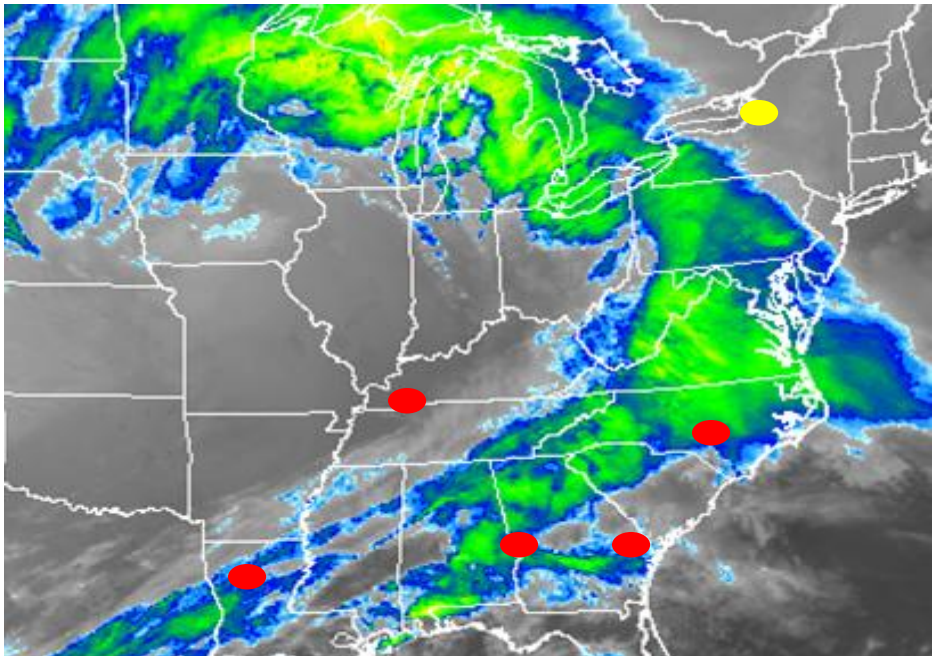
Saturday: Rain will persist through the day. Winds will remain out of the north around 12 mph until late afternoon. Low 46F, High 55F.
