You are hereby informed that the contract for the Lake Pontchartrain and Vicinity, Hurricane Protection Projects, LPV-12a.2, Jefferson Parish Lakefront, Duncan Pump Station, Breakwater and Bridge (W912P8-09-C-0106), at Kenner, Louisiana, in Jefferson Parish, has been completed. The project was completed by the United States pursuant to Public Law 109-234, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Hurricane Recovery 2006.


A joint agency final inspection of the project was conducted on October 27, 2010, and all contract work was found to be satisfactorily complete. In accordance with the Project Partnership Agreement between the Department of the Army and the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) dated September 22, 2008, the CPRA shall undertake the operation and maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, and replacement (OMRR&R) of this completed project feature of the Lake Pontchartrain and Vicinity, Hurricane Protection Project in Jefferson Parish.

In this connection, maintenance is construed as keeping all completed works in working condition to serve the purpose for which they were designed.
