#### FINAL REPORT OF THE UNISEA FLEET COOPERATIVE YEAR 2003

#### Presented to the North Pacific Fishery Management Council January 20, 2004

#### INTRODUCTION

UniSea Fleet Cooperative (UFC) is pleased to submit this document and results of their 2003 Bering Sea fishery to the North Pacific Fishery Management Council (NPFMC) in compliance with annual reporting requirements of the 1998 American Fisheries Act (AFA).

Year 2003 was the fourth year of UFC operations under the AFA. The UniSea fleet was managed and operated during 2003 following the successful model established during the preceding 2000-2002 fisheries--basically without change. This document format and 13 exhibits herein reporting UFC co-op members, management, allocations, catches, sideboard limits, prohibited species catches and enforcement is also consistent with UFC's earlier years reporting to the NPFMC. We believe this reporting format and detail is both in keeping with AFA reporting requirements and provides easy comparison to the prior year results.

#### UNISEA FLEET MEMBER VESELS AND CO-OP MANAGEMENT

Nine individual members representing 12 catcher vessels signed their fourth year co-op membership agreement on December 1, 2002, which enabled them to operate under the laws of the AFA in a fishery cooperative delivering pollock to UniSea Inc., during the 2003 fishing season (Attachment 1, UFC Membership Agreement, 2003 Addendum and Bering Sea pollock fishery harvest schedule).

Co-op management and administration also continued during 2003 and remained basically unchanged from management and administration of the three prior co-op years (Exhibit 1). Mr. Jeff Hendricks continued to serve as the president of UniSea Fleet Cooperative and Mr. Pete Maloney continued to serve as the UniSea coordinator. Coordination of information on allocations, transfers, pollock catches, sideboard catches and prohibited species catches between the UniSea plant in Dutch Harbor, the member vessels, Sea State, the Inter co-op Manager and the National Marine Fisheries Service all continued during 2003 as established in year 2000 and as conducted in 2001-2002.

## UFC BERING SEA POLLOCK ALLOCATION TRANSFERS AND CATCH

In 2003, UFC's 12 member vessels received initial AFA Bering Sea pollock allocations that totaled 150,568.000 mt. This initial pollock allocation to UFC represented 11.528% of the total Bering Sea directed pollock allocation and 23.056% of the inshore sector allocation. Exhibit 2 shows the distribution of 2003 pollock allocations between the seven inshore pollock cooperatives.

Each of the 12 UFC vessel's initial pollock allocations are identified in Exhibit 3 showing their tonnage and each vessel's percentage of the UFC total allocation. The F/V *Pacific Monarch's* allocation was transferred to ten other vessels in the UFC and divided up between those ten vessels as reported in Exhibit 4.

These initial pollock allocations were adjusted upward by 37.001 mt from release of pollock bycatch reserves during the 2003 season resulting in a UFC final pollock allocation of 150,605.000 mt. Exhibit 5 reports the final 2003 Bering Sea pollock allocations for each of the 11 active vessels in the UniSea fleet during the 2003 season after release of bycatch reserves and after in-season transfers of pollock allocations between member vessels.

Individual UFC member vessels directed Bering Sea pollock catches by the 11 vessels that operated are provided in Exhibit 6 and are compared to their respective final allocations. The UFC total directed Bering Sea pollock catch

totaled 150,417.425 mt, 187.819 mt under quota, representing 99.87% quota utilization during 2003. All UFC pollock deliveries but one, (203.299 mt) were made to their affiliated processing plant, UniSea, Inc. in Dutch Harbor, Alaska.

Bycatch of other groundfish, herring, halibut, crab and salmon from the directed Bering Sea pollock fishery is detailed by member vessel in Exhibit 7. Pollock represented 99.75% of the catch of pollock plus all other groundfish in the directed pollock fishery.

#### SIDEBOARD LIMITATIONS, ALLOCATIONS AND CATCHES

Initial sideboard limits for the UFC vessels totaled 8,518 mt as detailed by 18 area/species categories in Exhibit 8. The total sideboard catch was 3,617 mt representing about 42.5 % of the initial allocation. No individual area/species sideboard limits in directed fisheries were exceeded in the 2003 fishery.

Bering Sea Pacific cod comprised 4,159 mt of the 8,518 mt initial sideboard limit. The total Bering Sea sideboard cod catch totaled 3,412 mt, which consisted of 2,698 mt of directed cod catch and 714 mt of cod incidental to the directed pollock fishery. Bering Sea sideboard cod not harvested and not transferred to other co-ops totaled 947 mt.

UFC's sideboard allocations of Gulf of Alaska pollock totaled 2,136.450 mt across all areas and seasons, but remained un-harvested by UFC member vessels.

#### DIRECTED BERING SEA COD AND GULF POLLOCK FISHERY

UFC's directed Bering Sea Pacific cod allocations, transfers and catches for 2003 are presented in Exhibit 9 by member vessel. Seven UFC members conducted directed Bering Sea cod fisheries. The co-op's total Bering Sea Pacific cod initial allocation was 4,129 mt, 1,671 mt was transferred to another co-op (net transfers from within co-op and out to other co-op), and the UFC total directed cod catch

was 2,698 mt. A total of 3,102 mt of UFC's Bering Sea cod final allocation was

unused.

Bycatch of other groundfish, halibut, herring, crab and salmon in the UFC

directed Bering Sea cod fishery is detailed in Exhibit 10. Cod comprised 90.4%

of the total groundfish catch in UFC's directed Bering Sea cod fishery.

As earlier discussed, UFC member vessels did not fish Gulf of Alaska pollock in

2003, however 133 mt of the co-ops Gulf pollock allocation was transferred to the

Unalaska co-op (Exhibit 11).

DIRECTED CRAB FISHING

Eight of the UFC member vessels conducted directed crab fisheries during the

2003 season. Their crab catches by member vessel are reported in Exhibit 12

and totaled 281,531 pounds of Bristol Bay red king crab. UFC member vessels

did not conduct opilio Tanner crab fisheries in 2003.

UFC PROHIBITED SPECIES CATCH TOTALS

UFC member vessel total prohibited species catches of halibut, herring, Bristol

Bay red king crab, bairdi Tanner crab, other Tanner crab, chinook salmon and

other salmon from all directed Bering Sea pollock and cod fisheries are provided

in Exhibit 13.

UFC MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT

All UFC directed Bering Sea pollock and cod catches, as well as sideboard

catches and the halibut PSC were successfully managed and did not exceed

allocations. The co-op was accordingly not required to take any enforcement

actions.

Exhibit 1. Schematic of UniSea Fleet Cooperative Operations, year 2003.



Percent distribution of 2003 Bering Sea "inshore pollock allocation" between the seven inshore AFA pollock cooperatives.


