**Fiscal Year 2010 Announcement** 



The Peer Reviewed Cancer Research Program (PRCRP) was initiated by the U.S. Congress in fiscal year 2009 (FY09) for execution by the U.S. Army Medical Research and Materiel Command, Congressionally Directed Medical Research Programs. For FY10, the U.S. Congress directed \$15M for the PRCRP for the specified topic areas:

- ➤ Melanoma and Other Skin Cancers
- > Pediatric Brain Tumors
- Genetic Cancer Research and Genomic Medicine
- > Kidney Cancer
- **➣** Blood Cancers
- > Colorectal Cancer
- ➤ Listeria Vaccine for Cancer
- Radiation Protection Utilizing Nanotechnology

Individuals regardless of ethnicity, nationality, or citizenship status may apply as long as they are affiliated with an eligible institution and meet the specific Program Announcement requirements.
