Attached is the close of business, February 28, 2001, National Defense Reserve Fleet (NDRF) Inventory.

The NDRF program was established by the Merchant Ship Sales Act of 1946 and, today, it includes fleet anchorages at James River, VA, Beaumont, TX, and Suisun Bay, CA. Ships are held at the fleet anchorages and port facilities for national emergencies. After this service, they are required to be disposed of by scrapping through a ship breaker or be sunk as artificial fish reefs.

The only ships authorized to be located at the fleet anchorage facilities are those belonging to U. S. Government agencies. MARAD may also accept title of U. S. agency vessels of 1,500 gross tons or greater for disposal.

For your convenience, this report is now being posted on the MARAD Internet homepage. It is available from www.marad.dot.gov/offices/Ship/reserve_fleet.htm, and then look for and click on "Reserve Fleet Inventory". Note the addition of "/Ship" in the address. If you registered the prior address in your internet favorites, it will no longer work unless "/Ship" is added to the address line.

CHANGES:

- WASHINGTON arrived at D & D Steel, Brownsville, TX, on 02/09/01, being towed there under the scrap sales contract with ESCO Marine. Since, its disposal is being accomplished under the sale contract, it's title conveyed from MARAD to ESCO in February vice awaiting a certificate of destruction.

NOTES:

- HARKNESS, ex T-AGS 32, departed SUNY Maritime on 02/28/01 enroute to Massachusetts Maritime Academy (MMA) where it will serve as a static training platform while CAPE BON completes its conversion to a school ship. It is still eligible to furnish parts to the RRF when required.
- MARSHFIELD was downgraded from a JRRF fleet utility ship to disposal status in January 2001, however, the program code was not changed, causing the MARSHFIELD to incorrectly appear with the breakbulk vessels held in preservation status. This has been corrected in this February inventory.
- ALBERT J. MYER, T-ARC 6, and NEPTUNE, T-ARC 2, which were under consideration for selection as a training ship for Great Lakes Maritime Academy (GLMA) have been determined to be too large for GLMA by the President of GLMA.
