**October 2001 CHANGES:**

- Navy Reimbursable Custody vessel APL-57 departed and was withdrawn from the James River Reserve Fleet on 30 October 2001.

**NOTES:**

- The scrapping of WASHINGTON was completed on 10/11/01; scrapping continues on EXPORT COMMERCE (80% completed), LYNCH (90% completed) and EXPORT CHALLENGER (75% completed).
- GEN ALEX M PATCH was towed from the JRRF on 10/23/01 to be delivered to scrapping services contractor Esco Marine of Brownville, TX.
- Closing of the awarded sale of BENJAMIN ISHERWOOD to CCC Marine (for use as a NATO oiler) is pending. The sale of Henry Eckford (for use as a NATO oiler) is pending legal review.
- CRILLEY, CRANDALL, WAYNE VICTORY and SANTA ISABEL are expected to be towed from the JRRF in November to be delivered to scrapping services contractor Transforma of Brownsville, TX.
- MARAD is preparing to take title and custody of PERSISTENT (prospective GLMA schoolship) from the USCG in early November 2001. Transfer documentation has already been initiated by GSA.
