June 2004 Changes

- Reimbursable Navy vessel LEAHY was withdrawn from the SBRF under Navy tow on 21 June for scrapping in Brownsville, TX.
- Non-retention vessel ROBERT D. CONRAD (formerly JRRF) was destroyed under scrapping contract on 27 April (delayed notification).
- Non-retention vessel SANTA ELENA (formerly JRRF) was destroyed under scrapping contract on 4 June.

STATUS CHANGES and NOTES

- The status of PAN AMERICAN VICTORY was changed from Hold Indefinitely Non-retention to Ready for Disposal upon memorial support material being removed from her holds.
- The statuses of TEXAS CLIPPER (I) and GEN HOYT S VANDENDERG were changed from FISH REEF CANDIDATE to READY FOR DISPOSAL following a change in inventory classification policy.
- Locations of all ships currently under scrapping services contracts have been changed to their disposal sites.
- Downgrades from RRF as per 1 July 2004 USTRANSCOM guidance will be reflected in the July inventory report. Ships effected are ENTERPRISE, EMPIRE STATE, MISSIONS CAPISTRANO and BUENAVENTURA, and CAPES MENDOCINO, NOME, JOHN, JOHNSON and JUBY.
