POSITION DESCRIPTION

Caterpillar Equipment Maintenance Fitter (Mechanical Tradesperson)

MAJOR ACCOUNTABILITIES:

This position is responsible for the mechanical maintenance and diagnosis of a large variety of Caterpillar Machinery ranging across all sizes of dozers, rear dumps (off highway trucks – diamond mine trucks etc) graders, excavators and Caterpillar ancillary machinery, both in a workshop environment and across a number of different mine sites, as required. Maintenance activities shall be performed to ensure safe and reliable operation of the equipment.

SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS:

- Actively promote safety awareness within the group ensuring that all special requirements and standards are met.
- Comply with all safety procedures and standards.
- Be involved in the development of JSA's for tasks within area of responsibility.
- Assist in the development of work plans to effectively complete assigned jobs including tools, equipment and spare parts
- Perform routine mechanical maintenance activities, servicing, breakdown work and problem analysis to meet both daily and long term safety and machine reliability needs.
- Identify, initiate and implement equipment improvement opportunities.
- Undertake minor project work to improve equipment performance and safety.
- Review work procedures and PM's etc and provide feedback to ensure the maintenance system remains current and relevant.
- Respond to after hours service calls as required.
- Utilise the computer based maintenance system to record work history and parts usage.
- Utilise both computer based parts manuals and paper manuals
- Promote and assist in the development of all work group personnel in safety, technical and procedural issues.
- Develop and maintain knowledge and understanding of plant and equipment.
- Develop and maintain technical skills.
- Contribute to and support group decisions.
- Self motivated person that can work unsupervised whilst considering time management.
