

Flight Medicine sees a specific patient population based on flying status and their family members. The Family Medicine Clinic, including pediatrics, provides primary medical care to beneficiaries from birth to geriatric age for dependents of active duty members and retirees and their dependents. Specialty services include Women's Health, Physical Therapy, Mental Health, Audiology, Dental, and Optometry. Ancillary services include Clinical Laboratory, Radiology, and Pharmacy, Bioenvironmental Engineering, Army Veterinary Services, Public Health, the Health and Wellness Center (HAWC), and Family Advocacy that also support the base community.
