																			2. Operate on parking lots and sidewalks only.
																			3. Use of sidewalks mandatory when present.
																			4. Horn required when operated on roads.
																			5. Registration through GA Dept. of Public Safety required.
																			6. On post registration required.
																			7. Authorized for daytime use only.
																			8. Use of headlights at night mandatory.
																			9. Registration not required, if under 50cc.
																			10. On post registration required for vehicles over 50cc.
																			11. Operators under 21 are required to wear a helmet.
																			12. Headlights must be installed if operated at night.
																			13. No certification training required.
																			14. Operators / Passengers under 16 require helmets.
																			15. Sidewalk use prohibited.
																			16. Use only in approved areas.
																			17. Use of Seat belts required by Ga and 3 ID mandate.
																			18. Proof of registration required.
																			19. Minimum insurance requirements apply.
																			20. Registration through Ga Dept. of Motor Vehicles required.

Recommended ●

- Fort Stewart and Georgia laws prohibit a child between the ages of 1 and 4 riding as a passenger on a bicycle unless the child is securely seated in a child passenger seat, bicycle trailer, or infant sling and wearing a helmet.
- Vehicles operated on-post requiring insurance must be insured in the minimum amount of \$15,000 - \$30,000 personal liability and \$10,000 property damage.
- Motorcycle Operators must attend the Installation Motorcycle Safety Foundation Course.
