Who?



How?


This website is designed to be user-friendly and provide easy access to a large body of information. The above image shows the website's homepage. In order to effectively use the website, users will need to download and install the Adobe Acrobat Reader plugin for their browser (figure B). This website is best viewed in the latest version of Windows Internet Explorer.

<u>Site Organization</u>: The website is organized by the six color-coded tabs at the top of the screen (figure A):


- 1. Ideology and Education Pedagogy
- 2. Facilities for 21st Century Learning
- 3. Conceptual Adjacencies and Relationships
- 4. Space Types and Requirements
- 5. Design Guidelines
- 6. Supporting Documentation



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<u>Tabs</u>: As shown in the graphic above, clicking on any of the six tabs at the top of the window shows an expanded view with more topics related to each subject. Under each tab are related subheadings. Each subheading is a link to a Portable Document Format (PDF) file. By clicking the related subheading, the file will download and appear in the reading window below the subheadings. To return to the home page, click on the "home" button in the header of the page (figure 0). Click on the "Archives" button for a listing of file updates and links to archived version of these documents.



Navigation/Sizing: Once a file opens in the reading window, the Adobe Reader toolbar shows several options. (You may have to mouse over and click the Adobe logo near the bottom of the reading screen—figure G). Figure A shows the buttons for page navigation. Figure B shows how to size the file within the window.

<u>Downloading/Sharing/Printing</u>: When a file is open, the document can be searched (figure C), emailed (figure D), printed (figure E), or saved to a local drive for reading offline (figure F). Once an option has been selected, users simply click the

appropriate button and follow the instructions.
