Protect Yourself!

Fraud of all types is much higher during the holiday season so while you are out, make sure to protect yourself and your Navy/Marine Cash Card. If your wallet is lost or stolen, report it immediately!

Before going shopping, empty out the contents of your wallet onto a photocopier and copy each side of your cards, including your drivers license, Social Security and credit cards. If you do happen to lose your wallet here is some valuable info that may transform you from being a victim to a victor.

- 1. Cancel or freeze credit and debit cards immediately, including your Navy/Marine Cash Card. Have toll free numbers and card numbers handy so you know whom to call. For Navy/Marine Cash, call the NICC (next page) and select the Cardholders option.
- 2. File a police report in the jurisdiction where it was stolen, this shows credit providers you were diligent. It's also the first step towards an investigation.

But here's what is perhaps most important:

3. Call the three national credit reporting agencies immediately to place a fraud alert on your name and Social Security number. Once your identity is stolen, thieves can apply for additional cards in your name.

Credit cards are protected federally so, report it immediately, and follow up.

Who are you going to call?

There are many numbers floating around but how do you know who to call and when? Well, the easy answer is that you can call the Navy Integrated Call Center (NICC) for One Touch Support (OTS)! The NICC has many options to choose from so make sure you select the right option to get transferred to the correct agency's help desk or you'll have to call back!

For example, below, when you call the NICC and press Menu **Option 6** (called ATMs At Sea, Navy Cash Card, MPCC, and WINIATS) you get the 5 additional options listed below. DISBO's press **3** to gain assistance and they are connected **directly** to the CSC's help desk in New Jersey. Pressing **4** for MPCC will connect **directly** to the FRB's help desk in Cleveland, Ohio.

(Help Desk in New Jersey)

6 – **4** MPCC —

(Help Desk in Ohio)

6 – 5 WINIATS

(Help Desk in Indiana)

CSC -- For **all** Navy Cash issues:

- Hardware and software questions
- Questions on your Navy Cash reports
- Transaction questions
- Lost or Stolen Cards

FRB -- For all MPCC issues:

- Scanner Problems
- Questions regarding your MPCC reports
- Transmission Problems

The benefits of using the NICC are having one number to dial for everything (OTS) and it's a free call. There is a toll free number and a DSN number that you may use.
