Additionally, all Letters of Intent require the Division G3 (or BDE S3 if unit is a separate BDE) signature. The RTB will not accept team submissions through any other channel. The RTB will conduct an analysis of all Letters of Intent and determine team allocations NLT 03 FEB 2012.
