



## **Local Restaurants**

Carter's Courthouse Café – Route 36 East, Turn left on 6<sup>th</sup> Ave., Make right on Laprade Ave., Make Left on Main St., Make left onto 224 North Main St. Hopewell

Kan Pai (Japanese Restaurant) - Route 36 East (Take a right at Main and 6th St Gates)

**Shoney's** - The Crossings Shopping Center, Route 36 East (Take a right at Main and 6th St Gates)

**Denny's** - Route 36 East (Take a right at Main and 6th St Gates)

**McDonald's** - across from Denny's on Rte 36

Taco Bell - next to McDonald's on Rte 36

Waffle House - (Beside Hampton Inn) Route 36 East (Take a right at Main and 6th St Gates)

**El Nopal (Mexican)** - Route 36 East (Take a right at Main and 6th St Gates). Take a right at third stop light.

**Southpark Mall** - on Route 144 (Temple Avenue - straight across the red light from the Ft Lee Commissary Gate on Sisisky Boulevard) has **Lonestar Steaks**, **Red Lobster**, **Arby's**, **Applebee's**, **Golden Coral**, **Ruby Tuesday**, **China Buffet**, **Old Counrty Buffet**, **Outback Steak House**, **Panera Bread Company**, **and Five Guys Burgers & Fries**.

Sagebrush Steak House - Follow Temple Avenue. At third light (Arby's and Red Lobster), turn left.


Cross through next red light will be on right (K-Mart shopping center, across from Target and Walmart)

**Olive Garden -**Follow Temple Ave to third light and take left at Arby's. At next light take a left and down about 1/8 of a mile on right side is restaurant.

**La Carreta** (Mexican) - Temple Avenue. At third red light (Arby's and Red Lobster), turn left. Restaurant will be just passed the car dealership on left.

**Downtown Petersburg** Brickhouse Run (British Pub), Leonardo's (Italian)

**Hopewell – Jordan Point Road** Dockside Restaurant (Seafood) adjacent to Benjamin Harrison Bridge. Take Route 10 south form Hopewell, follow signs for Plantations and Route 5.





## Adverse Weather Notification

- Notification of Fort Lee personnel:
