



What's in your Supplement?

Androstenedione, otherwise known as "Andro", and androstenedione precursor supplements are illegal to purchase or use. These are classified as controlled substances and use is punishable under the Uniform Code of Military Justice.

The following is a list of androstenedione precursors that are banned. Be alert! These products may possibly be in the supplements you are purchasing. Be informed and read product labels carefully!
