IMPORTANT NOTICE - Summer Flounder Fishery to Remain Open

Dear Federal Permit Holder:

This letter is to inform you of the National Marine Fisheries Service's (NMFS) decision not to close the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) to commercial and recreational fishing for summer flounder. The Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission (Commission) met on April 3, 2001. At this meeting, the Commission agreed to adopt the lower total allowable landings (TAL) for summer flounder of 17.91 million lb implemented by NMFS in the 2001 Specifications for the Summer Flounder Fishery (March 23, 2001; 66 FR 16151), and consistent with the Settlement Agreement in the 2000 NRDC et al., v Daley case. As a result, closure of the EEZ to summer flounder fishing is no longer necessary.

For your information, a table is provided below listing the initial and, due to overages in 2000, the adjusted 2001 commercial summer flounder quotas by state, as published in the 2001 specifications. Landings will be prohibited in each state when that state's quota is attained.

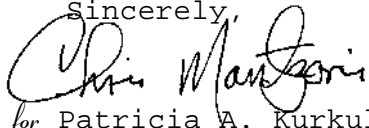
