A final determination regarding the eligibility of the vessel to be issued the limited access «MULTS1» «SCALLOP1» «LOBSTER1» «FLUKE1» «SCUPI» «BSB1» «LOLIGO1» «ILLEX1» «QUAHOG1» «MNK1» permit(s) in question will be made once the complete and correct application has been received by the NMFS Permit Office before the specified deadline. If, after 45 days from the date of this letter, a complete and correct application has not been received by the NMFS Permit Office (including all required vessel logbook submissions), the limited access permit(s) identified in this letter cannot be renewed in the future. Please take note that limited access permits must be renewed each year before the last day of the fishing year or the permit(s) may not be renewed in the future.
