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### **GYPSUM IN THE FIRST QUARTER 2012**

Producers mined 2.38 million metric tons (Mt) of gypsum during the first quarter of 2012 (table 1). This amount was 9% more than that of the fourth quarter of 2011 and 6% more than that of the first quarter of 2011. Synthetic gypsum production was 1.88 Mt in the first quarter of 2012 (table 1), which was 7% more than that of the fourth quarter of 2011 and 5% more than that of the first quarter of 2011. During the first quarter of 2012, synthetic gypsum accounted for about 38% of the 5.01 Mt total supply of gypsum in the United States. Both mined and synthetic gypsum are used as raw material for wallboard. The wallboard industry is the leading domestic consumer of gypsum.

Sales of uncalcined gypsum in the first quarter of 2012, mainly for portland cement manufacture and for agricultural uses, were 351,000 metric tons (t) (table 2), which was 7% less than those of the fourth quarter of 2011 and 33% more than those of the first quarter of 2011.

Sales of calcined gypsum for the first quarter of 2012 (table 1) was 2.99 Mt, which was slightly more than that of the fourth quarter of 2011 and slightly less than that of the first quarter of 2011. Sales of board products (table 2) were 3.57 Mt, equivalent to approximately 398 million square meters (4.28 billion square feet), which was 4% less than those of the fourth quarter of 2011 and slightly more than those of the first quarter of 2011.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, imports of crude gypsum in the first quarter of 2012 were 751,000 t (table 3), a decrease of 13% from those of the fourth quarter of 2011 and 6% less than those of the first quarter of 2011. Mexico accounted for 45% of crude gypsum imports, followed by Spain with 33%, and Canada with 22%.

Gypsum wallboard imports for the first quarter of 2012 were 63,400 t, equivalent to 7.1 million square meters (75.9 million square feet). These imports were 11% less than those of the fourth quarter of 2011 and 32% more than those of the first quarter of 2011. Mexico accounted for 58% of wallboard imports, followed by Canada with 41%.

Wallboard exports to 39 countries and territories in the first quarter of 2012 were 239,000 t, equivalent to 26.6 million square meters (286 million square feet). This amount was 13% more than that of the fourth quarter of 2011 and 25% more than that of the first quarter of 2011. Most wallboard exports were shipped to 28 western hemisphere countries, with Canada accounting for 94%.

All percentages in this report were computed based on unrounded data.
